

Happy February Chapter F,

Yea!! It is February. I get excited about February for a couple reasons. First off, it is Cabin Fever Month. So that means I get to spend a long weekend in a beautiful state park lodge with a group of crazy/funny people that like the same thing as me. Motorcycling!! In addition, these same people like to play Euchre, games and laugh at all the silliness going on around us. Even more important, they all like to eat good food and talk about all the above.

The second thing I like about February is we are starting to notice the daylight sticking around a little longer. The weather usually has more nicer days than bad days. That pesky groundhog usually see's his shadow and predicts 6 more weeks of winter weather but he is only correct about 37% of the time. This means there is 63% chance he will be wrong again this year. So, hurry up spring.

I spent a little time looking at safety reports online. The last real comprehensive motorcycle report was the "Hurt" report from 1981. There has not been funding appropriated from the Feds to do another fully comprehensive report since that time. It appears that most of the findings still hold true today, however.

- 75% of accidents were found to involve a motorcycle and a passenger vehicle, while the remaining 25% of accidents were single motorcycle accidents.
- In the single vehicle accidents, motorcycle rider error was present as the accident precipitating factor in about two-thirds of the cases, with the typical error being a slide-out and fall due to overbraking or running wide on a curve due to excess speed or lack of side bite.
- Almost half of the fatal accidents show alcohol involvement.

Injury severity increases with speed, alcohol involvement and motorcycle size.

- In the multiple vehicle accidents, the driver of the other vehicle violated the motorcycle right-of-way and caused the accident in two-thirds of those accidents.
- The report's additional findings show that wearing appropriate gear, specifically, a helmet and durable garments, mitigates crash injuries substantially.
- Vehicle failure accounted for less than 3% of these motorcycle accidents, and most of those were single vehicle accidents where control was lost due to a puncture flat.

Weather is not a factor in 98% of motorcycle accidents.

The failure of motorists to detect and recognize motorcycles in traffic is the predominating cause of motorcycle accidents. <u>Conspicuity</u> of the motorcycle is a critical factor in the multiple vehicle accidents, and accident involvement is significantly reduced by the use of motorcycle headlamps-on In daylight and the wearing of high visibility yellow, orange or bright red jackets.

So, the things we as a group know and try to do is:


Wear the gear to protect us from the fall.

- Do not drink alcohol and ride our bikes.


