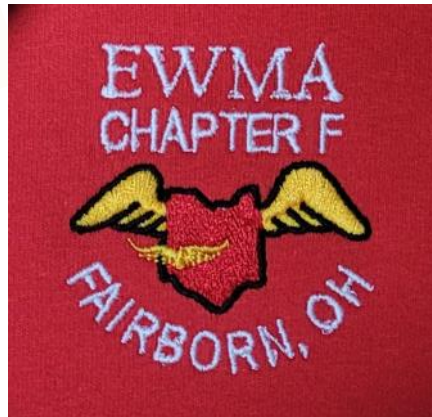

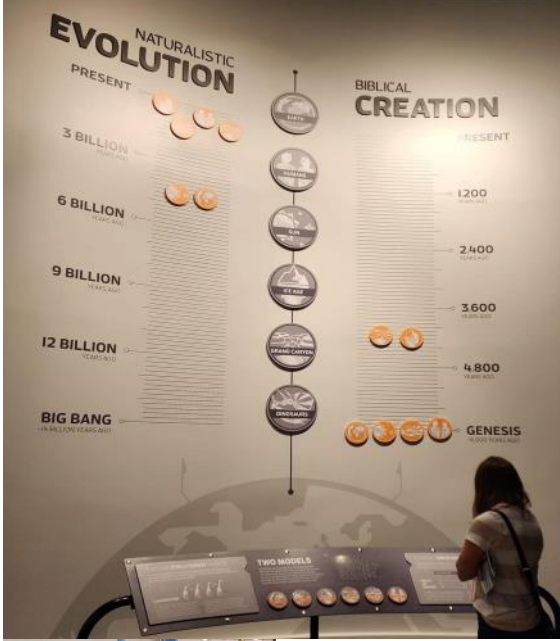
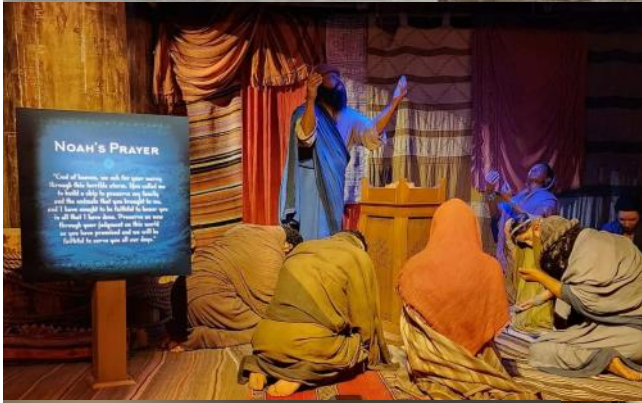

TWELVE STONES MONUMENT
Why Do These Stones Mean?

After miraculously crossing the Red Sea to escape the wrath of Pharaoh, God freed Israel from the grasp of their Egyptian oppressors. The Lord instructed Moses to take 12 stones and place them on the banks of the Jordan River. He said to Moses, "Take 12 stones from the Jordan and place them on the east bank of the river. When you have done this, you will remember the day when the Lord brought you out of Egypt. You will say, 'The Lord brought me out of Egypt.'"

On July 5, 2016, the Board of Directors of the Christian Heritage Center announced the construction of the Twelve Stones Monument. The monument is a stack of 12 stones, each representing one of the 12 tribes of Israel. The monument is located on the grounds of the Christian Heritage Center in Pigeon Forge, Tennessee.

"These twelve stones stand for the twelve tribes of Israel. When you see these stones, you will remember the day when the Lord brought you out of Egypt. You will say, 'The Lord brought me out of Egypt.'"

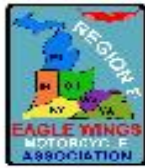

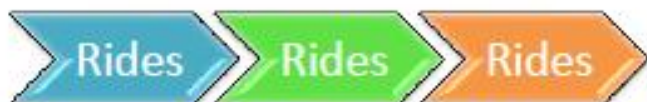
