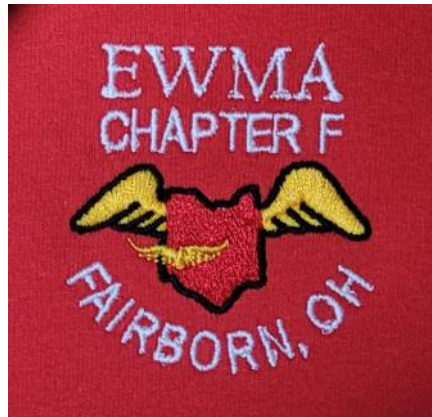

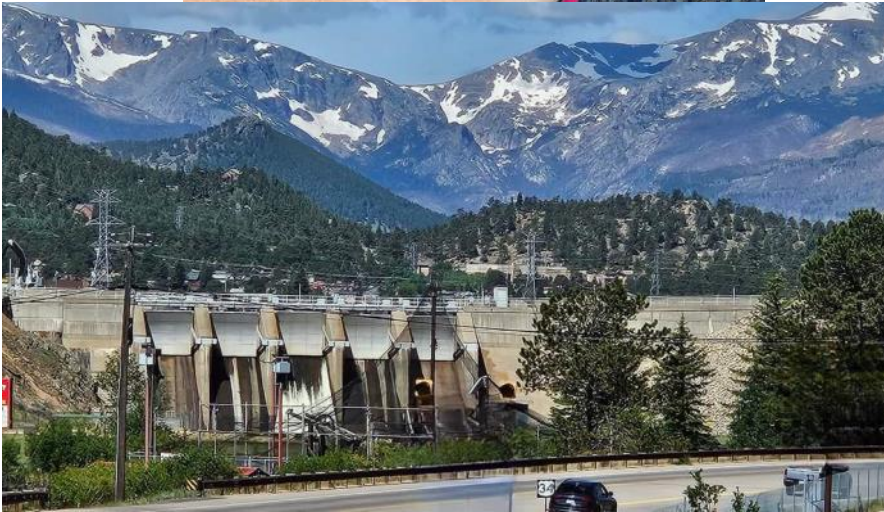
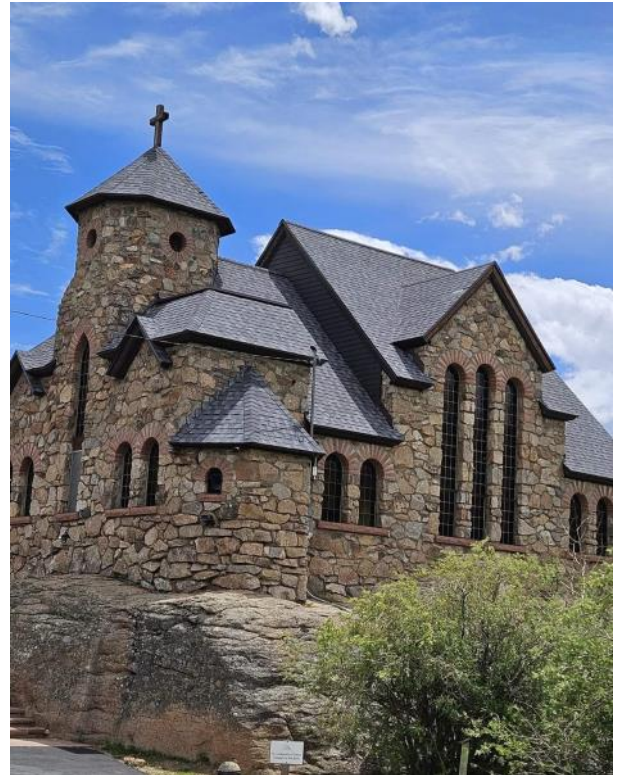
This is our Region!! Region F consists of these six districts (states). We want all of us to form a great big family!! But not just limited to Region F, there are 44 more states to have fun with!!

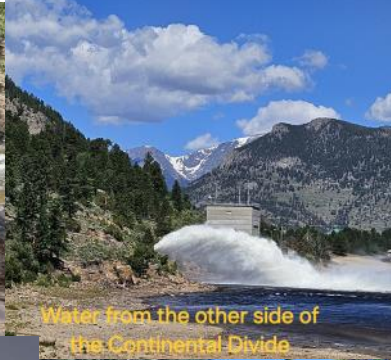

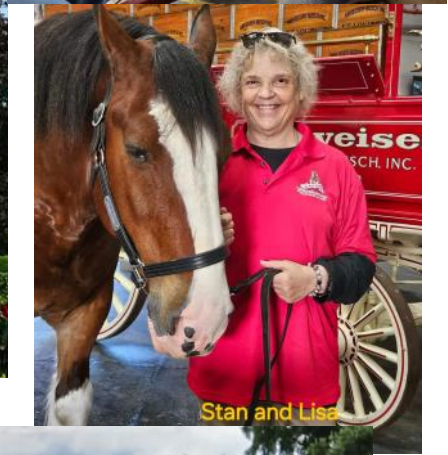

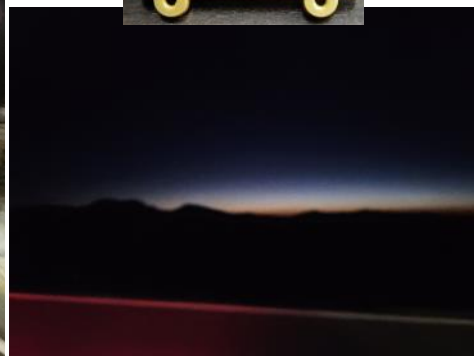
