Eagle Wings will be three years old soon! How time flies, but Eagle Wings keeps getting better as time goes on.


Let's make our number one priority for 2025 RECRUITMENT of new members! It's how we sustain EWMA and keep the fun rolling.

The Lighter Side - HOA's and Silos Chris Toomer - VP of Operations

One of my favorite songs is <u>Wide Open Spaces</u> by The Chicks. Admittedly, I love their lead singer's voice! The first verse easily describes long-distance riding and being a member of EWMA.

Who doesn't know what I'm talkin' about Who's never left home, who's never struck out To find a dream and a life of their own A place in the clouds, a foundation of stone

Last year, on my way to EWMA Rendezvous from Parker, CO to Green Bay, WI, I had a lot of time to just think... It was a quiet time in my mind, the rarity of which I truly cherish as my job is a daily exercise in multitasking and switching gears constantly. I'm mentally exhausted at the end of the day. Long-distance riding provides time for *mental meditation*. I have time to notice things and ponder them. I also make stuff up and need to yell "Tally Ho!" at 75 mph while thrusting my arm forward! Don't judge! You know you're going to do that on your next ride now... You're welcome! And do let me know when you do that (email ewma.vp.cd@gmail.com). I'll keep count and report it in a future OTF. Send pictures if you can!



The dreaded HOA, or Homeowners' Association, mandates requirements to keep the neighborhood in line with the HOA's expectations. This can be the color of the paint, the number of trees in the front yard, the roof color, the driveway condition, and anything else that detracts from or enhances the neighborhood. As I motored through Iowa, Minnesota, and Wisconsin, I noticed active HOA activity.

Did you know that homes visible from the highway across these 3 states are required to have at least one silo? Most homeowners choose the taller, slimmer versions. Wealthy homeowners may choose to have four or more silos to flaunt their prominence. Other homeowners will choose the stubby versions that are wider but shorter in stature. These seem to be frowned upon by the HOAs as they are not photographically interesting and are rare in sightings from the highway.

Another HOA requirement appears to be paint color. Barn Red is clearly a preferred color for houses and outbuildings, but white and green seem to be acceptable. When traversing these states, it is unlikely that you'll see a homestead that is painted in shades of blue, yellow, or other colors. Interestingly, white roofs appear to be easily approved. Where I live, a white-ish roof is absolutely forbidden despite the huge benefits in the summer months to reducing attic heat buildup.

My HOA mandates a front yard lawn and 2 trees, so we have a Colorado Blue Spruce and an Autumn Blaze Maple (stunning colors in the Fall) representing our compliance with the mandate. While the benefits of xeriscaping on water conservation are well known, our HOA hasn't quite figured that out yet. Similarly, you'll likely never see a xeriscaped yard from the highway across the Midwest. Rather, it appears that Midwest HOAs require corn or another green crop to be planted and maintained. Notably, irrigation equipment is hidden underground where I live. Center pivot and linear drive systems are most prominent in Iowa, Wisconsin, and Nebraska. I sought approval for a more minor center pivot to irrigate a 300° partial circle with the non-irrigated section pointed at my house. I was to plant yellow daisies so it looked like Pac Man eating my house. DENIED!

Limiting the number of pets that can live at one address is another rule my HOA enforces, with 3 pets being the maximum. Traversing the West and Midwest will reveal HOAs that are much more lenient. For instance, instead of corn, homeowners appear to be able to plant special grasses in their yards. They let their pet cows roam freely and eat the grass,

which has the added benefit of not requiring weekly lawn mowing that we city dwellers must endure.

It also appears that the HOAs and Visitor Bureaus require locals to drive the latest






farming equipment down the road (at super slow speed for maximum enjoyment by road-sharing visitors) or even to drive through their yards mowing and spraying to engage and excite visitors to their state. Pickup truck owners who choose to lift their trucks have nothing on the monster tractors and elevated spray rigs that Midwestern homeowners use as daily drivers. A pickup truck will never be as cool as a tractor.

I enjoy my rides through the Midwest and appreciate

the different requirements and expectations that local HOAs have for their residents. I hope you enjoy your cross-country rides and appreciate the fun *The Lighter Side* can reveal.





It will not take as long to get used to the new trike as switching from 2-wheels to 3wheels.

We are looking forward to our new adventures and meeting everyone.
