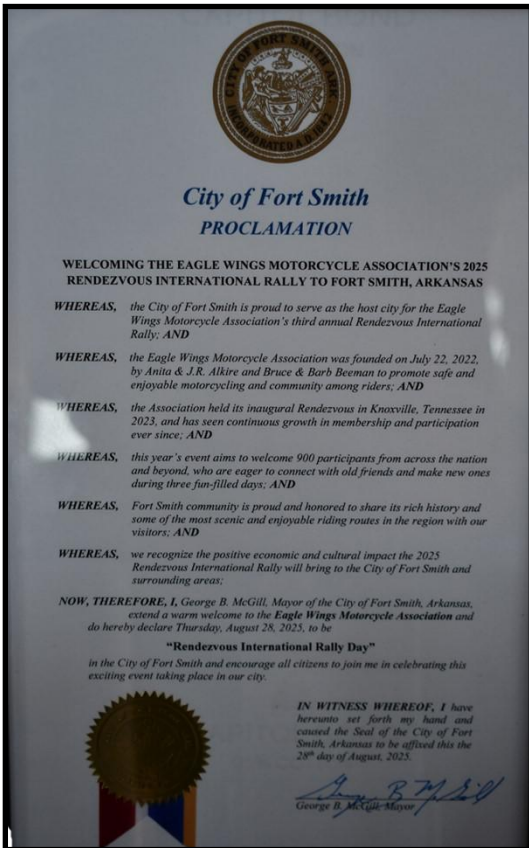

Safe riding to those who can and fun off bike together time to those who can’t.

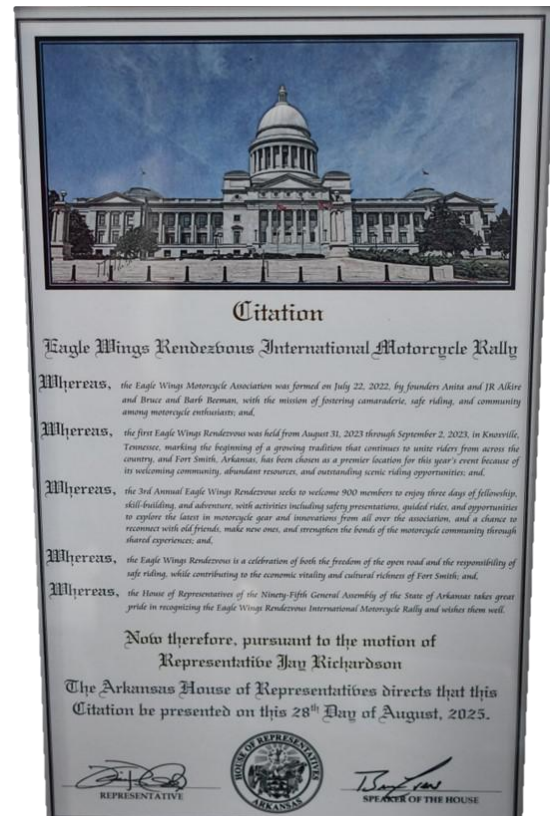

Both the hotel the Wyndham and Ft Smith Convention Center were excellent venues and provided the amenities we needed to successfully host the Rendezvous.

We'd have to say that these Rendezvous rallies are getting better and better with each passing year.

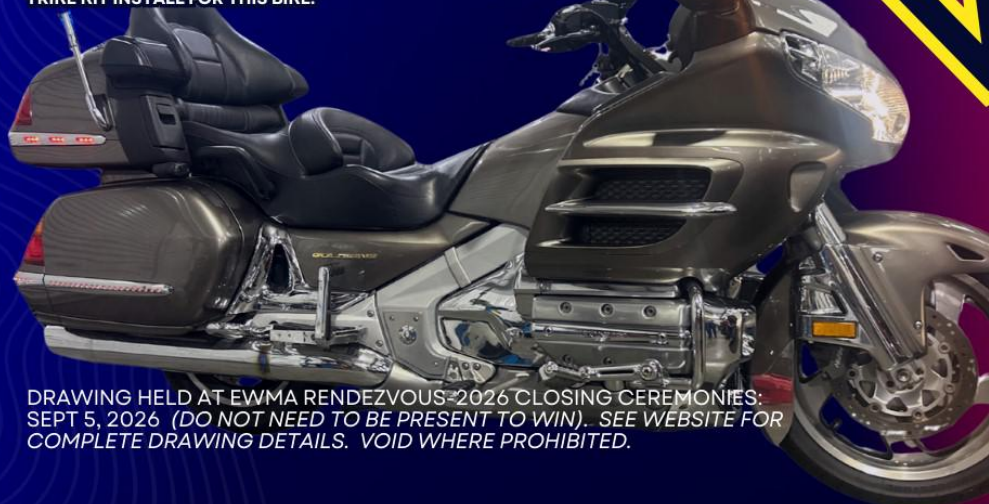

That Wonderful, Beautiful Time of Year!

As our riding season, for most of us, crawls to an end, I am reminded of my favorite season! It is a colorful and beautiful time of the year. Yep! You guessed it! Our Financial Reporting Season!

We owe it to our members to keep accurate records of our unit's income and expenses. Nature's colors, which we will see in the coming weeks, help us remember what to record in our financial records. I know it is a stretch but stay with me! The ever-present evergreens, some boldly green and others milder green, remind us of our income to our bank accounts. Similarly, the reds, yellows, and amber colors remind us of the expenses we incur and should be recorded accurately.

There are many ways for us to track our income and expenses. My favorite tool is the "EWMA Financial Register and Report." This spreadsheet, while perhaps looking a bit ominous, is quite easy to use and provides a very quick summation of your year's finances if used throughout the year, or even if just used in December for the entire year. If you haven't been using this spreadsheet and would like to finish 2025 with it, you may obtain a copy from our website.

To do so, you must first log in to our website, at <https://www.ewma-world.org/>, using your login ID and password. Once logged in, hover your mouse over *Member Resources* in the banner header. From the resulting dropdown menu, click on *Documents*. From the next list, click on *Financial/Treasurer Info*. That will take you to a list of available financial documents. For your year-end financial reporting, you will at least need to download the "Financial Report Checklist-FILLABLE-01-20-2025." If you plan to use the spreadsheet for your 2025 report, please download the "2025 Financial Report Spreadsheet." Be sure to read the instructions for the spreadsheet before you enter any data. The *Instruction* worksheet will appear when you first open the spreadsheet. For now, only the 2025 spreadsheet is available. The 2026 spreadsheet will be posted to our website in early January 2026.

Once your 2025 forms are complete, your Director needs to sign them in the appropriate spaces and send them to the next-level Director for concurrence and signature. In other words:

- Chapter reports go to District Directors,
- District reports go to Region Directors, and
- Region reports go to the VP of Finance.

Financial Reports should be completed by January 31

Later this year, I will reiterate these instructions in emails to all the Directors and Treasurers. Never fear, I have not forgotten our IRS 990N reporting due right after January 1, 2026. Instructions for those filings will be forthcoming at the end of the year!

Meanwhile, continue to enjoy your riding weather wherever your location allows! Nothing is quite as exhilarating as wind therapy, regardless of the season! 1st on the scene

What Are You Going to Do? When The Day Turns BAD!

We make a plan, excitement fills the air, and we're all set for a great day on the road... the possibilities are endless.



Then the day gets turned upside down, and we have parts & pieces to deal with. The unpredictable is part of each day that we get on our motorcycle and go riding.

Preparedness is our best option to make it through a bad day!

Why should we want to take a 1st Aid/CPR/AED course? **Minutes** is the best response to the question... Those minutes can be the difference between an outcome where we ride again

with friends in the future or having to plan to attend a funeral.

In the event of an accident, having the skills to provide immediate first aid can be crucial. It can help stabilize an injured person until professional medical help arrives. That knowledge is the critical link in a 'Chain of Life'.

For those who have been at a motorcycle accident scene, you will understand the enormous stress that is experienced. Utilizing a toolkit of 1st Aid / CPR training can help control stress and provide the best opportunity for a positive outcome in the situation.

The HSI 1st Aid/CPR/AED course covers a broad section of 'Basic' skills that make a difference in everyday situations, outside of the extremes of an accident involving a bike. Knowing CPR can significantly increase the chances of survival for someone experiencing cardiac arrest. The sooner CPR is administered, the better the outcome. The 1st Aid Techniques teach us how to handle various medical emergencies, such as choking, bleeding, and fractures, which can be critical in saving lives.

An area that is important to understand, which is covered in our training, is Legal and Ethical Responsibility that you take when rendering aid. Motorcyclists, like all road users, have a moral and sometimes legal obligation to assist others in need (*as some state laws note that aid "Shall" be rendered*). Being trained allows you to fulfill this responsibility effectively.

A summary of Good Samaritan Laws can be found at www.safeproject.us. Once we understand this, we can more effectively feel comfortable rendering aid to those in need.

The need for trained riders/citizens makes a difference, regardless of the situation, whether it's a motoring accident, an incident at home, an office, or even a social gathering.

We don't wish to have a situation where we must deal with a medical airlift, but by taking on the old Boy Scout motto to '**Be Prepared**', that moment can mean life or death for a close friend or a complete stranger.

Being trained means you are prepared, making you a valuable resource in your community.

We hope that, upon reading this, you will consider taking the 1st Aid/CPR/AED course or refreshing your skills at the next EWMA event or rally.
