1st on the scene

First Aid / CPR

After my last article, I can hear what you're thinking – "Todd, I want to take a First Aid/CPR class, but there are none available in my area." I feel your pain.

EWMA has 18 First-Aid/CPR instructors:

2 in South Carolina

7 in Florida

1 in Wisconsin

2 in Illinois

l in Minnesota

l in Missouri

2 in Arkansas

2 in Canada

That leaves some BIG holes. There are entire regions with no instructors. What can we do about that? Do you know how to teach? Would you like to learn?

Our instructors are all certified through HSI (the Health & Safety Institute), the organization that accredits us. HSI has a course to teach you how to teach. It is a hybrid course; by that, I mean part of it is online, and part of it is in person with an Instructor Trainer. We have two Trainers.

At home or on the road - are you prepared????



HOWEVER

If you hold current teaching credentials from just about any nationally recognized institute of learning, there's a good chance you won't need to take HSI's course. You do not need experience in any medical or First Responder field; if you can teach and are able to prove it with credentials, chances are, HSI will let you.

Here's a catch-22 of the situation: People can't take the course because there's no one in their area to teach it. There might have been an instructor in the area once, but there were not enough students to support them. We Instructors have to teach at least one class per year to keep our certification current, but the class we teach earns the students a two-year certificate. There must be enough students in the area to support the teacher every year.

So, gather up a group of fellow students, volunteer one of them (or yourself) to teach, and we'll get you up and running.





Family Members can use the Primary Member's login to access our website. You can also be logged in on different devices simultaneously.

Renewal Process
