## Did you Know About this Motorcycle Information?

This is a column I hope you will enjoy as it will be everything about Motorcycling. History, Apparel, Do's and Don'ts, Bloopers, Friends, Events Etc.

Today is our history

20th century mass production emerged. 1901 English Triumph, then North American Harley Davidson in 1903 credited with Military Police.

By 1920s or early 1930s the BMW came on the scene.

1931 Indian and Harley-Davidson were only two American manufacturers and rivalry in the US.

In

1937 Joe Petrali set new land speed record of 183 mph on modified Harley Davidson.

World War II included motorcycle for military use and BSA supplied British armed forces starting in 1937-1950. 125cc light-weight motorcycle dropped in a parachute fitted tube cage from aircraft was produced.

After World War II Americans found a replacement for Camaraderie, excitement, danger and speed of life at war with motorcycles. Grouped into loosely organized clubs, motorcycle riders in the US created a new social institution, the MOTORCYCLISTS of Bikers which Marlon Brando's 1953 film *The Wild One* referred to as outlaws.


Honda became the largest motorcycle manufacturer in 1959, followed by Kawasaki. British manufacturers: Triumph, BSA and Norton retained a position on market.

In late 1960s and early 70s the rise of Japanese, led by Honda, was a tool of a life to a toy of a lifestyle. Motorcycles were a recreational machine for sport and leisure, a vehicle for carefree youth, Suzuki, Kawasaki and Yamaha.

Today, Honda, Kawasaki, Suzuki, Yamaha, Harley Davidson, BMW, Indian, Ducati, and Triumph, even cheap scooters, mopeds, and Vespa's are all a pleasure to those who love to ride. Some have added Trikes and trike kits, but what matters most is the joy each and every one has riding together.


Brief history but hope you get the point: it's not what you ride, but that you ride!!
